ORDINANCE 1-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PINE, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE PINE TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE, NO. 1 OF 2016, TO ALLOW HOSPITALS AND PROFESSIONAL OFFICES AS PERMITTED USES IN THE R-2 GENERAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT AND TO PROVIDE LOT, YARD AND HEIGHT STANDARDS FOR THOSE USES.

SECTION 1. Table 305A of the Pine Township Zoning Ordinance, No. 1 of 2016, enacted April 4, 2016, is hereby amended to include Hospitals as a Permitted Use the R-2 General Residential Zoning District. **SECTION 2.** Table 305A of the Pine Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to include

Professional Offices as a Permitted Use in the R-2 General Residential Zoning District.

SECTION 3. Table 305B of the Pine Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to provide for the following lot, yard and height standards for Hospitals in the R-2 General Residential Zoning District:

Hospitals

Minimum Lot Area 5 acres Minimum Lot Width 200 feet

Minimum Front Yard 75 feet, measured from Street

Centerline (except for Interior Streets as defined; which may use the alternative standard under

Section 703D)

Minimum Side Yard20 feetMinimum Rear Yard20 feetMaximum Height of Structure40 feetMaximum Lot Coverage35%

SECTION 4. Table 305B of the Pine Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to provide for the following lot, yard and height standards for Professional Offices in the R-2 General Residential Zoning District:

Professional Offices

Minimum Lot Area ½ acre
Minimum Lot Width 100 feet

Minimum Front Yard 75 feet, measured from Street

Centerline (except for Interior Streets as defined; which may use

the alternative standard under

Section 703D)

Minimum Side Yard 20 feet
Minimum Rear Yard 20 feet
Minimum Height of Structure 40 feet
Maximum Lot Coverage 35%

SECTION 5: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective in seven (7) days.
